- Lead & support team to deliver analytical NPI deliverables in support of programme delivery in Eirgen.
- Support Product Development & Innovation pipeline in Eirgen representing Analytical Development team.
- Develop & adapt Analytical Development & Transfer team structure to support Eirgen business strategic growth plans.
- Develop & maintain Analytical capacity model in conjunction with NPI lead to enable/maintain NPI program planning and delivery.
- Support & coach Senior Chemists in project management & customer management as part of NPI deliverables.
- Responsible for Analytical R&D department budget management and capital programme.
- In conjunction with relevant managers ensure alignment of approaches for cleaning verification & validation across the Campus manufacturing areas, including OSD & Packaging.
